Dear Mr. Macklem:

At its October 4, 2012 meeting, the Gas Tax Agreement's Management Committee made funding decisions for the Regionally Significant Project Fund applications. I am pleased to advise that your applications for the following projects have been approved for RSP funding of the lesser amount indicated or 100% of the actual eligible costs of each approved project:

Regional Active Transportation Project, \$2,247,315.00
Regional Housing Strategy Project, \$150,000.00
Air Quality Management Project, \$38,000.00
Septic Treatment Upgrades Project, \$780,000.00
Centrifuge Project, \$317,969.00

Details of the funding, and recipient obligations in relation to it, will be set out in the Funding Agreements between UBCM and the Regional District of Central Okanagan. Funding is subject to execution of the Funding Agreements, completion of the projects and compliance with recipient obligations set out in the Agreements.

Since the grant amount is based on the total actual eligible costs of the project and payment of the grant is contingent on completion of the project, UBCM cannot release the full amount of the approved grant until the project is complete.


However, in order to minimize interim financing costs, UBCM will consider making progress payments prior to project completion, provided UBCM has sufficient Gas Tax Funding on hand to do so. Details of the payment schedule and progress payments, if available, will be set out in the Funding Agreement.

Please note that the Gas Tax Agreement includes a Communications Protocol (Schedule G). Recipients that are planning to undertake communications are reminded that the Protocol requires these to be done jointly with the parties of the Gas Tax Agreement. Please contact Paul Taylor, UBCM's Relationships and Communications Advisor (250-356-2938; ptaylor@ubcm.ca) in order to ensure that all communications fulfill the requirements outlined in Schedule G. Also, please refer to the UBCM website for information on the new Gas Tax signage requirements for temporary construction signage.
