Regarding your Spring 2013 RDCO Water Talk letter proposing a new lower consumption rate threshold for all Regional District Water Systems, the undersigned is opposed to the 62% reduction from 235 cubic meters threshold to 90 cubic meters threshold without reducing the original cost per cubic meter.

The undersigned is strongly opposed to the above reduced consumption rate threshold without reducing the previous cost. In essence, I am paying 62% more for the 90 cubic meters as opposed to the original 235 cubic meters. This is unfair and is an unnecessary cost to home owners.
