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A bylaw to provide for the imposition of fees and charges against the owner or occupier of real property located within the service area boundary, or connected to the Regional District of Central Okanagan Killiney Beach Water System.

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WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan is authorized by separate bylaws to provide for the regulation, operation, maintenance, and improvements of various water systems located within the Regional District of Central Okanagan;

NOW THEREFORE, THE REGIONAL BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN, IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Every Owner of property and/or premises situated within the service boundary of the Regional District of Central Okanagan Killiney Beach Water System Service Area shall pay to the Regional District the fees and charges established in accordance with this Bylaw, as prescribed in Section 2 of this bylaw.
  - a. User fees shall apply to all parcels connected to the water system where the water service is turned on.
  - b. An Owner may apply to the Regional District Officer for a one-time full or partial exemption of the consumption based user fees in the event of an emergency or unexpected usage due to failure of a portion of private service works or similar occurrence.
  - c. Asset renewal fees shall apply to all parcels, vacant or otherwise, and shall commence immediately upon registration of a property in the Land Title Office.

Payments must be received by December 15th to ensure adequate processing time at year end.
