By law, all dogs in the Central Okanagan must be licensed. Starting January 2014, there will be Zero Tolerance for dogs that are not licensed.

4. Go paperless with your bills, credit cards and bank statements: receive them electronically or view them online.
5. Switch to online yellow pages www.yellowpages.ca
6. Reduce computer paper in your home by reading documents on screens, always print double sided if you must print.
7. Get your latest magazine subscription or books digitally
