Highlights of the Regular Regional Board Meeting – July 28, 2014

Proposed Shooting Facility

The Regional Board believes it's premature to support a referral application from Front Counter BC for a proposal to develop a trap and skeet shooting facility on Crown Land in the upper Trepanier area. The Central Okanagan Shotgun Sports Club has asked the Provincial agency to approve a 30-year License of Occupation for its plans to develop the facility on a 23.22-hectare parcel of vacant Crown Land. The Regional Board recommends that Front Counter BC not approve the application until such time as a rezoning application is approved by the Regional District changing the parcel zoning designation from RU1 Rural 1 to C6 Recreational Commercial. The Board says this process provides an opportunity for property owners affected by the proposed zoning change to comment at a Public Hearing.

Temporary Use Permit for Medical Marijuana

The Regional Board has given conditional approval for a Temporary Use Permit for a medical marijuana production facility proposed for Paradise Valley Drive. The proponent has applied for a Federal license to produce medical marijuana from a building that's being retrofitted on a 4-hectare parcel in the Trepanier area. The property owner is requesting the Permit in order to seek subdivision consolidation with two adjacent properties in order to meet the 8-hectare minimum parcel size required by the Regional District for medical marijuana production. To receive the Permit the applicant must meet a number of conditions including completion of and adherence to recommendations of a Wildfire Risk Assessment Report; addressing how it will impact water in the area and receipt of a license by Health Canada. As well, if the properties are consolidated into one parcel, a variance must be approved by the Regional District for building setback requirements.

Regional Parks Service Review


