## Highlights of the Regular Regional Board Meeting – August 25, 2014

### Joint Park Management Contract

The Regional Board has approved an agreement with the District of West Kelowna for the Regional District to manage the municipality's parkland as a portion of Glen Canyon Regional Park. As part of the five year agreement, the Regional Parks service will construct a trailhead and parking area at Gellatly Road with a trail developed through the municipal parkland that was acquired by West Kelowna in 2012 below Canyon Ridge Estates. This agreement and subsequent improvements will enhance the visitor experience from the lower portion of Glen Canyon through the existing Regional Park. The District of West Kelowna Council has also approved the agreement.

### Regional Park Fishing Dock Donation


The Regional Board has approved a donation of an accessible floating dock for Shannon Lake Regional Park. The \$15,000 donation comes from the Freshwater Fisheries Society of BC, the Province of BC and the Habitat Conservation Trust Foundation and includes installation of the new dock. Community, stakeholder and partner agencies provided their support for the proposed dock in order to enhance the fishing experience and support expanded Regional Parks programming. The Regional District will now apply to the Provincial Government for required approvals to allow installation of the dock.
