Highlights of the Regional Board Meeting – August 24, 2015

Special Events Permits

The Regional Board has approved two Special Events Permits for the Kelowna Dirt Bike Club fall season. The club can hold two special race events at its facility adjacent to Bear Creek Forest Service Road that are exempt from provisions of the Noise Bylaw. One event will be held September 5th and 6th, while the second date is to be determined. All other activities at the track including Wednesday and Sunday practises are subject to a mutual consent order which restricts bikes to a maximum sound of 96 decibels.

Temporary Use Permit Renewal

The Regional Board has given conditional approval to renew a Temporary Use Permit for up to three years for a medical marijuana production facility proposed for Paradise Valley Drive. The proponent has requested the renewal of the permit (first issued in July 2014) to accommodate Health Canada inspection and licensing of a facility on a 4-hectare parcel in the Trepanier area. The property owner is also in the process of seeking a lot consolidation/boundary adjustment with two adjacent properties in order to meet the 8-hectare minimum parcel size required by the Regional District for medical marijuana production. To receive the Permit the applicant must update the Regional District within six months on the status of issues related to the lot consolidation application and Health Canada license. As well, if the properties are successfully consolidated into one parcel, a Variance application must be approved by the Regional District for building setback requirements.

Green Communities Reporting

Efforts by the Regional District to work towards achieving Climate Action Charter commitments have been acknowledged by the joint BC-Union of BC Municipalities Green Communities Committee. The RDCO has created a baseline inventory and reporting of corporate greenhouse gas emissions. Work will now continue on efforts to reduce emissions and achieve carbon neutrality.

Secondary Suite Application

The Regional Board has given first reading to a Zoning Amendment bylaw application for a one-hectare property in the 4500 Block of Trepanier Road in the Central Okanagan West Electoral Area. The owners intend to develop a legal secondary suite within the proposed single detached house, to replace a house that was destroyed by fire in December 2013. A Public Hearing will be scheduled and advertised.

Electoral Area Grant-in-Aid

The Regional Board has approved the following Grant-in-Aid for the Central Okanagan East Electoral Area:
